Objectives:

- To demonstrate integration of cross-curricular concepts (Science, SS, Math) and illustrate the value of role play across disciplines
- To demonstrate reinforcement of key ELA concepts in a variety of curricula
- To showcase the value of primary resources and working with institutions in one's community

Overview:

Teachers will participate in a multi-station hands-on workshop that will include activities in Patriots Point's Naval and Maritime Museum's Flight Academy, Education Center and various tour routes aboard the USS Yorktown. Novel techniques for integrating science, math and social studies will be addressed in the Flight Academy while teachers will also get a chance to fly a WWII aircraft. Teachers will analyze primary documents recently added to the museum's collection of WWII naval aviation exhibits from a corsair pilot that flew from the deck of the USS Yorktown CV-10, bringing their flight experience full circle. Tour route activities will weave together reading comprehension, critical thinking, math, SS, and science while exploring journaling techniques. All stations will include resources to use and share in the classroom.
