## D. DEPARTMENT OF MARKETING REPORT

Sam Elkin gave the following report:

- Events and Exhibits The USS Laffey event was a tremendous success. Ms. Elkin shared a brief video from Live 5 news coverage of the event. Sam Singewald brought his replica of the USS Laffey, made entirely of LEGOs, along with eight other warships to the event. Bricks & Minifigs a local toy store donated 57 gallons of LEGOs for the event. Guests could build their own Laffey model and enter to win a prize. Chris Hauff's son, Jonah won second place in the contest.
- Agency Projects The Marketing team is in the process of updating the Operations Overnight webpage to include a new promotional video.
