PAINT STOWAGE ROOM UPGRADES

Patriots Point Development Authority, ("PPDA"), is accepting quotes for upgrades to our paint storage room aboard the museum ship ex- USS Yorktown located in Mt. Pleasant, SC.

Patriots Point is an agency of the State of South Carolina. All bidders must have a Vendor Registration number which is retrievable on the State of South Carolina website. Your SC Vendor number must be listed on your bid submittal along with all your contact information. Your submittal must match the information on the Vendor registration site. Successful bidder must accept a State of SC Purchase Order along with payment terms.

The successful bidder will be a company that normally engages in the field of fire protection systems.

Description:

Upgrades to include and be according to NFPA-12 guidelines.

New CO2 cylinder /system flex bends.

Rebuild existing activation valve mechanisms

Work to install new piping, nipples and fittings attached between CO2 bottles manifold for testing purposes.

Cylinder service to recharge and hydro two each 75# cylinders.

All labor and misc materials.

Optional:

Install one each flame tight ventilation damper and provide electrical service to wire into system enabling closing in the event the CO2 system discharges.

Install one each flame arrestor at existing round porthole and wire to close upon discharge of system.

All costs of delivery are to be included in this price. There will be no upcharges allowed for incidental costs to the successful bidder without prior approval. Price will be all inclusive, including any taxes.

Ship check may be arranged by calling the contact listed below. Site visits between the hours of 8 am – 12pm Monday – Friday. Ship check is recommended. There are no other bid specifications or information furnished.

Bids not received by the due date or that do not comply with the minimum specifications or trade provision will not be considered. Any questions or concerns regarding changes should be addressed in writing by email in advance of the bid date. PPDA reserves the right to reject any and all bids for convenience of the government.

Bids will be opened on September 16, 2025 at 10:00 am onboard the ship and must be dropped off at the Patriots Point Pier Security Guard Shack no later than 9:00 am on said date. Bid will remain sealed until time of opening. We are located at 40 Patriots Point Road in Mt. Pleasant, South Carolina 29445.

All bidders will be notified by email with the results after tabulation. The successful bidder will be notified by phone. All bidders will receive a compilation of submitted bids after opening.

All work will be performed and completed within 45 days of the bid opening date.
