LOW SPEED VEHICLE PROCUREMENT

Patriots Point Development Authority, ("PPDA"), is accepting quotes for one "Low Speed Vehicle" to be used in transporting museum guests from parking lot down the pier and to the ships.

Patriots Point is an agency of the State of South Carolina. All bidders must have a state vendor number which is listed on the State of South Carolina procurement website. Your SC Vendor number must be listed on your bid submittal along with all your contact information. Your submittal must match the information on the Vendor registration site. Successful bidder must accept a State of SC Purchase Order along with state payment terms.

(For reference: LSV must be equal to or better than the Journeyman LSV 4+2 model package from Columbia, however all makes and models will be considered. Referenced model specifications should be considered the minimum requirement for your make/model package to include stated warranty and option equipment. Option equipment would only be those items listed below under description that are not included in the base package.

Include any applicable information or pamphlets on your LSV with your bid submittal for consideration.

Description:

LSV must meet or exceed the requirements of NHTSA CFR Title 49-571-500 with all state of South Carolina mandated accessories. Glass windshield desired. All applicable on road safety features.

Minimum passenger capacity and GVWR: 2,500 pounds, 6 passengers.

4 forward & 2 rearward facing passenger arrangement w/canopy top cover and side rain flaps included.

Minimum 96" wheel base.

Minimum 2-year warranty on drivetrain and body parts.

48v battery pack – High capacity, 240 amp hour min. Single point battery watering system.

GFCI protected onboard charger with cord capable of plugging into standard 110vac outlet.

Once award is made, delivery will be made to buyer's facility within 30 calendar days maximum. Failure to deliver will be grounds for default with the buyer having the option of cancelling or selecting the next lowest bidder at no cost to the government.

Bids not received by the due date or that do not comply with the minimum specifications will not be considered. Any questions or concerns regarding changes should be addressed in writing by email in advance of the bid date. Customer reserves the right to reject any and all bids for convenience of the government.

Bids will be opened at April 07, 2024 at 10:00 am onboard the ship and must be dropped off at the Patriots Point Pier Security Guard Shack no later than 9:00 am by said date. Bid will remain sealed until time of opening. Emailed bids will not be accepted.

All bidders will be notified by email with the results after tabulation. The successful bidder will be notified by email and/or phone contact. All bidders will receive a compilation of bid submitters and pricing after tabulation.

Specify on your bid envelope the bid number and "Patriots Point Low Speed Vehicle Bid" and SC Vendor number.
