



PATRIOTS POINT DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY INVITATION FOR BID
120 AAH87JDC9JA2AN Motorola CP100d UHF Handheld Non-Display Radios

Patriots Point Development Authority, ("PPDA"), is accepting bids for 120 Motorola CP100d UHF Handheld Non-Display Radios with a rechargeable battery and charger to be used for staff to communicate while operating on the grounds of Patriots Point. This is a re-solicitation, all previous bidders can resubmit a bid.

Patriots Point is an agency of the State of South Carolina. All bidders must have a state vendor number which is listed on the State of South Carolina procurement website. Your SC Vendor number must be listed on your bid submittal along with all your contact information. Your submittal must match the information on the Vendor registration site. All bidders must be an authorized Motorola dealer and submit proof of this authorization. Bids will include unit price, extended price for 120 radios, shipping/delivery charges, and total. Successful bidder must accept a State of SC Purchase Order along with state payment terms.

For reference: Radios must be equal to or better than AAH87JDC9JA2AN Motorola CP100d UHF Handheld Non-Display Radios. Referenced model specifications should be considered the minimum requirement for your make/model package to include stated warranty and option equipment. Option equipment would only be those items listed below under description that are not included in the base package.

Include any applicable information or pamphlets on your radios with your bid submittal for consideration.

Once award is made, delivery will be made to buyer's facility within 30 calendar days maximum. Failure to deliver will be grounds for default with the buyer having the option of cancelling or selecting the next lowest bidder at no cost to the government. Bids not received by the due date or that do not comply with the minimum specifications will not be considered. Any questions or concerns regarding changes should be addressed in writing by email in advance of the bid date. Customer reserves the right to reject any and all bids for convenience of the government. PPDA reserves the right to test the radios upon delivery.

Bids will be opened on September 11, 2026 at 10:00 am onboard the USS Yorktown and must be dropped off at the Patriots Point Pier Security Guard Shack no later than 9:00 am by said date. Bid will remain sealed until time of opening. Emailed bids will not be accepted.





All bidders will be notified by email with the results after tabulation. The successful bidder will be notified by email and/or phone contact. All bidders will receive a compilation of bid submitters and pricing after tabulation. Specify on your bid envelope the bid number and "Patriots Point Motorola Radios Bid" and SC Vendor number. – Attn: Chris Jones, Operations Director.
