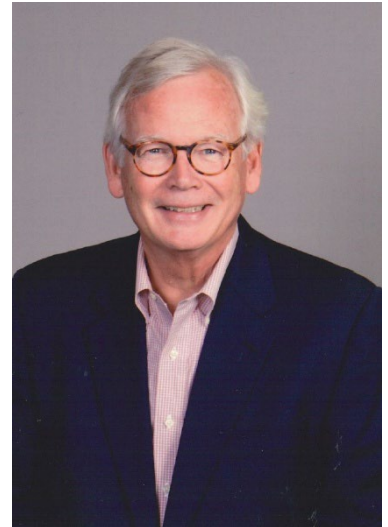
## **Patriots Point Development Authority Announces Appointment of Jules Anderson to Board**

In addition, five members are appointed by the governor upon the recommendation of a combination of the Speaker of the House, Senate Pro Tem, Senate Finance Chairman, Chairman of the House Ways and Means Committee, and the adjutant general. The mayor of the Town of Mount Pleasant serves as an ex-officio member.
