South Carolina Business and Civic Leader Joins PPDA Board

MOUNT PLEASANT, S.C. – South Carolina Governor Henry McMaster has approved the appointment of David Riggins to the Patriots Point Development Authority (PPDA) Board.

A native of South Carolina, Riggins was born in Greenville and raised in Gaffney. He is a graduate of Gaffney High School and Limestone University, where he later served on the Board. He is the founder and President of D.P. Riggins & Associates, Inc., a Charlotte-based sales agency established in 1982 that has become a recognized leader in supplying custom metal and plastic components to Original Equipment Manufacturers.

Riggins brings a long-standing commitment to civic engagement to the PPDA Board. He has held advisory and leadership positions on several academic boards, including the Clemson University Board of Visitors, the Winthrop University Business Administration Advisory Board, and the Wofford College President's Advisory Board.



In addition, Riggins is a passionate advocate for children's welfare, having served for more than three decades as a Board member and four years as Chairman of the Crossnore School and Children's Home, which supports underprivileged youth in the Carolinas.

Riggins' commitment to service is deeply rooted, not only through his professional and philanthropic work, but also through a personal connection to military history, as his father served in World War II—a legacy that makes his role at Patriots Point especially meaningful.
